

Population of Latvia 1.9milj (2021)



- · Social media as a trendsetter, influence feelings




THERE ARE NO "AWAY" or "OUT"





How many **KG of materials** one person in EU use per year? (main groups of resources: biomas, energy (fossil, coal etc), metals, minerals)






Concept of Circular Economy

Generate huge amount of waste









What is the % we can reduce the negative impact on the environment if we plan and design product properly?






In the design stage, it is possible to reduce **80%** of the products negative impact (in the life cycle)




