DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What is the circular economy, and how does it differ from the traditional 'use and throw away' model?

How does this shift impact our environment and the way we consume products?

2. Getlini Eco is an example of a circular economy in action. How does this facility transform waste into valuable resources, and what are the benefits of such processes?

Can you think of other facilities or initiatives that have adopted similar circular practices?

3. One key feature of the circular economy is viewing waste as a productive resource. How does this mindset change the way we handle waste, and what are some examples of waste being repurposed into new products?

Do you think these practices could be implemented in your community or household?

4. Circular economy also promotes the use of services instead of owning products. What are some examples of this, and how might they contribute to reducing waste and conserving resources?

Can the sharing economy (like bike-sharing or tool libraries) play a role in this? How?

5. The circular economy emphasizes 3E values: Environmental, Economic, and Emotional sufficiency. How do these values influence the success of circular initiatives like Getlini Eco?

Why is it important to consider not just the environmental and economic impacts, but also the emotional or societal impacts of our consumption habits?
